### **S. Main Street Bridge Preliminary Plans – Todd Smeltz, Erdman Anthony**

- The plans are being reviewed by Larson Designs
- The bridge will be built in two stages (eastern side – 1<sup>st</sup>, western side 2<sup>nd</sup>).
- Right of Ways – They will need to go to the property owners and ask them to purchase the right of way. This will be about 5% of the borough's budget.
- Susquehanna Civil will work with Veolia.
- There will be no reduction of weight restrictions.
- Todd will reach out to Wally's.
- There will need to be a meeting in April for the officials from borough council, Susquenita School District, Marysville Fire Company, East Penn Ambulance, Rohrer Bus etc. Carl suggested having the meeting in the VFW ballroom.
