

## **MARYSVILLE BOROUGH POOL RULES & REGULATIONS**

- Prior to admittance, season members must present their membership card. Lost or stolen cards must be replaced at the member's expense.
- Daily patrons are permitted to leave and re-enter the pool without paying an additional fee on the day they paid the entrance fee.
- Marysville Borough Pool will be open for swimming during posted scheduled hours. Entry into the pool enclosure, when it is closed to the public, is punishable by fine and/or imprisonment. Pool hours may be adjusted relative to available pool staff, weather, and various other factors affecting pool operations.
- It is the prerogative of the pool management and the Marysville Borough to close the pool at any time for reasons deemed necessary; (e.g. electrical storms, chemical imbalances, maintenance needs, etc.).
- Each child eleven (11) years of age and under must be accompanied by a mature, responsible person (minimum age of 16).
- Adult swims: adults may take their children 6 and younger, into the shallow end. The deep end of the pool is for adults 18 years and older. The adult swims are at the discretion of the lifeguards.
- On the decks and in the water, attire will be limited to standard swimsuits. Cut-off shorts are not permitted in the water. No diapers are permitted in the pool. Those requiring diapers must wear pants approved for swimming (e.g. Little Swimmers).
- The following attire is prohibited, both in the pool and in public areas of the pool premises: thong-style, transparent, see-through, or otherwise revealing swimwear. Patrons who fail to comply with these standards may be asked to leave the facility.
- Distracting the attention of a lifeguard, except in an emergency, is prohibited.
- Showers are recommended prior to entering the pool.
- Glass containers are prohibited within the confines of the Marysville Borough Pool.
- Patrons are required to place their trash in the proper waste or recycling receptacles; when leaving, they should pick up their trash and dispose of it properly.
- Smoking, use of all tobacco products, and vaping is prohibited at the Marysville Borough Pool.
- Alcohol, illegal drugs or illicit substances are prohibited from Marysville Borough Pool; possession of these substances will result in termination of pool privileges and may result in criminal prosecution. Persons under the influence of alcohol or narcotics are prohibited from being on the pool premises.
- Engaging in the following behavior or refusing to obey the instructions of pool management or Lifeguards will result in removal of pool privileges on a temporary or permanent basis.
- Running on the pool deck; pushing, dunking or throwing swimmers; diving from the sides of the pool in the shallow water; and swimming in the slide area are prohibited.
- Foul language, fighting, horse play, bullying and sexually inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated.
- Depositing foreign material into the pool is prohibited. Spitting, spouting water, or discharging body waste is prohibited.
- Any person with an infectious or communicable disease is prohibited from using the pool.
- Persons with open sores or blisters are advised not to use the pool, and may be prohibited from entering the water.
- Animals or pets of any kind are prohibited from the pool area; animals providing specialized assistance to handicapped individuals are permitted (e.g. service animals). Service animals must have appropriate documentation and vaccination records available upon request.
- Firearms, explosive devices, or weapons of any kind are prohibited at Northside Pool. Possession of these items will result in termination of pool privileges and may result in criminal prosecution.
- Restricted areas, such as chemical storage filter rooms, lifeguard shack, and inside concession stand may not be entered by patrons.
- The cost of any property damage shall be charged to the responsible member, including damage caused by the guest of the member.
- The Marysville Borough and Pool Management is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged property.

**WADING/BABY POOL** - The wading/baby pool is not under the immediate supervision of a lifeguard. Parents and/or Guardians are reminded that children in the wading/baby pool are **THEIR** responsibility. The wading/baby pool is for children under the age of 6.

**SLIDES** – (1) No horseplay, pushing, running or cutting in line. (2) You must slide and enter the pool feet first. (3) Clear the landing area or exit the pool by the ladder. (4) One slider at a time—no stopping.

**DIVING BOARD** – (1) If you are using the diving board for the first time you may be asked to show a lifeguard you can swim a section of the pool. (2) Only one person at a time is allowed on the board; only bounce is permitted. (3) You may NOT enter the water backwards or dive to the side. (4) After diving, please exit the area immediately. (5) Be courteous and patient when there are smaller children on the diving board and in the water below.

Pool Management has the right to evict any person for violation of rules contained herein and for any other obvious improprieties. Penalties may include suspension of pool privileges, temporarily or permanently.

These rules and regulations are subject to changes as deemed necessary by the management and all rules and regulations are subject to change as deemed necessary by the Marysville Borough.
